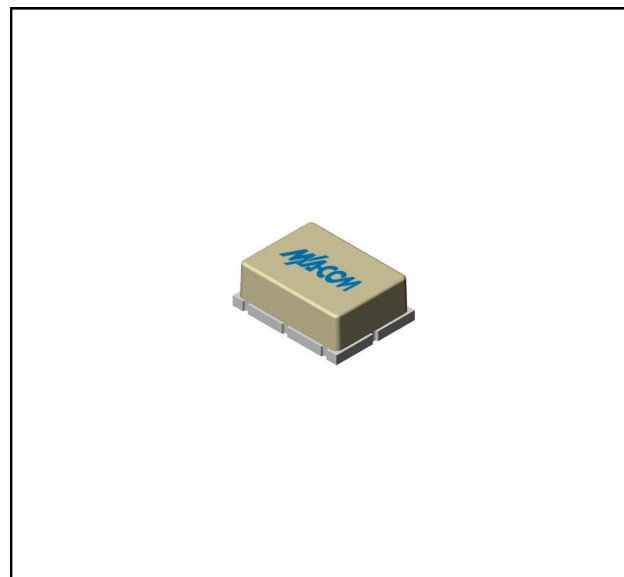

Description

The CSFD26 is a passive bridge diode frequency doubler, designed for use in the high volume wireless and test equipment applications. The design utilizes Schottky bridge quad diodes and broadband baluns to attain excellent performance. Due to the use of high temperature solder and welded assembly processes used internally makes it ideal for use in semi-automated and automated assembly. 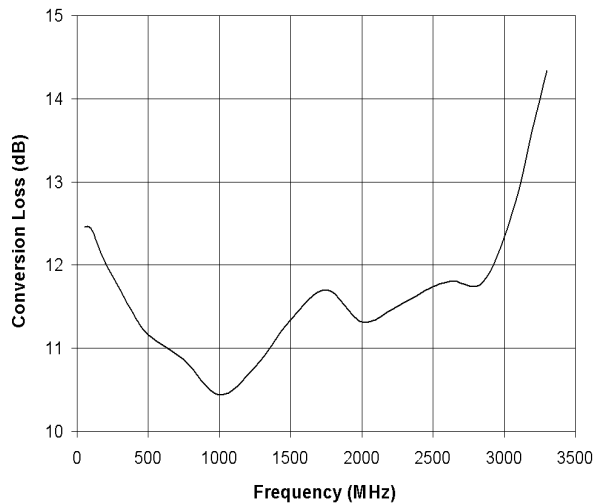

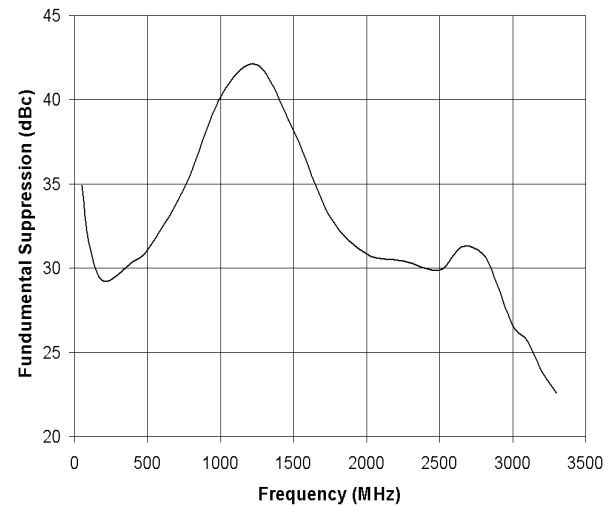

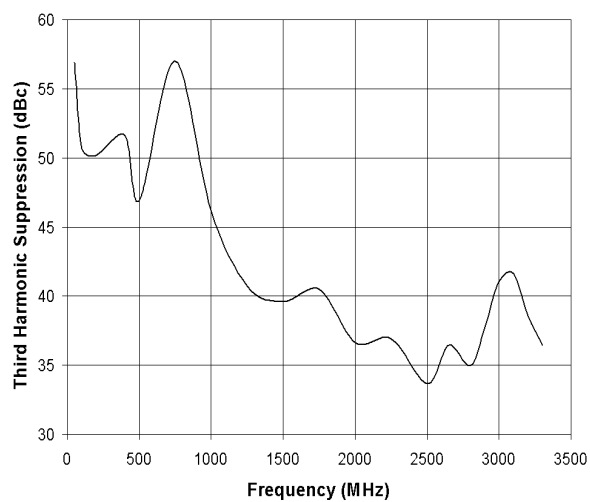
Conversion Loss vs. Frequency



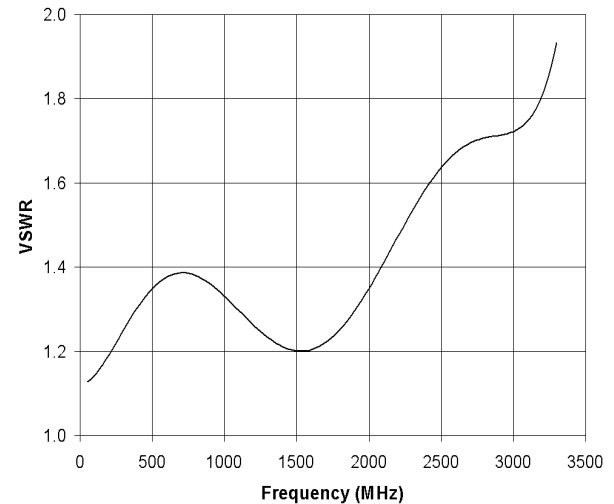
Fundamental Suppression vs. Frequency

Input VSWR vs. Frequency



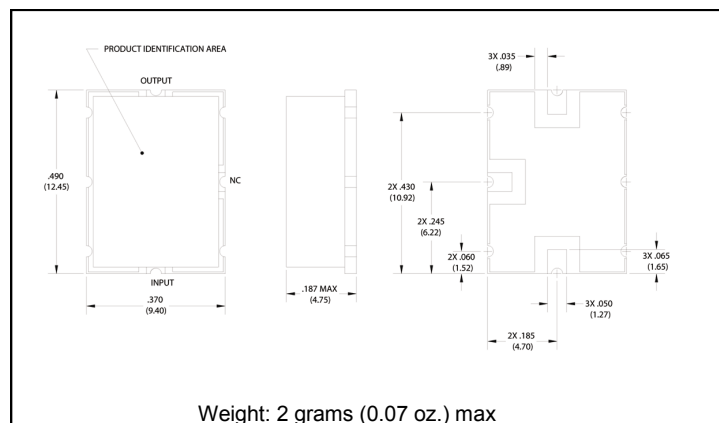
